

Dear Liquor License Owner,

Multiple bills were introduced in the 2024 Legislature that, if passed, would have dramatically increased liquor excise taxes. Our lobbyist was vocal in our opposition to these measures that aim to decrease consumption of alcohol by everyone, including responsible drinkers.

We fought, and the bills did not pass in the short, 30-day session. But legislators made clear their intent to continue the excise tax discussion during interim committee hearings that precede the 2025 Session.
